

We study prophecy because:


- (1) God chose to tell us about important future events.

How Should Prophecy Be Studied?


- We must understand each text in its plain ordinary use of the language.







A COVENANT is an agreement between two parties.




A CONDITIONAL COVENANT is one in which certain things must be fulfilled by the receiver before the giver is obligated to fulfill what he promised.

An UNCONDITIONAL COVENANT is one in which the giver fulfills what he promised regardless of what the receiver does.

{ The Church Age }

- 1. Israel blinded so Gentiles could get saved.
- 2. Church contains both Jews and Gentiles.
- 3. Christ revealed to people for redemption.
- 4. Separate distinct first coming of Christ.
- 5. Restraint of evil by God.
- 6. Great apostasy develops.
- 7. A new method by which God received men into His presence apart from death.

This Present Church Age

Contrast of Past Ages to Present Church Age

Past Ages (Old Testament)

- Christ is anticipated
- Holy Spirit came only on certain men for certain tasks.
- Good news is anticipated.
- Revelation is incomplete.
- Believers are promised blessings in this life.
- Nation of Israel is the object of God's dealing.

Present Age (New Testament & Today)

- Christ has come, died, raised, and is seated at the right hand of the father.
- Holy Spirit indwells every believer.
- Good news announces accomplished salvation through Christ.
- Revelation is complete.
- Believers are promised persecution in this life.
- Israel set aside from God's dealing and should not expect fulfillment of His promises during this age.







Distinctions Between the Rapture and the Second Coming

RAPTURE

SECOND COMING

All believers are removed from the earth.

Christ never appears on the earth.

The saints are caught up into the air

Christ comes to claim a bride.

The tribulation is about to begin.

It is an imminent event (anytime).

It brings a message of comfort.

It is a mystery (not revealed in O.T.)

Believers are rewarded.

All non-believers are removed from the earth.

Christ appears to all the earth.

Christ returns to the earth.

Christ returns with the bride.

The Millennial Kingdom is about to begin.

It is preceded by a multitude of signs.

It brings a message of fear and judgement.

It is revealed in both Testaments.

Gentiles and Israel are judged.





4 The Pretribulation Rapture

Distinctions Between the Rapture and the Second Coming

RAPTURE

SECOND COMING

Creation is unchanged.

The Gentiles as a group are unaffected.

Israel's covenants are unaffected.

Takes place before the day of wrath.

The expectation of the church is: "the Lord is at hand" (Phil. 4:5)

The church is taken into the Lord's presence.

Creation is changed.

The Gentiles are judged.

Israel's covenants are fulfilled.


It follows the day of wrath.

The expectation of Israel is:





5 Events for the Church Following the Rapture

Event No. 1 THE "BEMA SEAT" OF CHRIST

WHAT: "bema" = "reward seat" (not judicial)

WHEN: Right after the Rapture

Reward is associated with Resurrection (Luke 14:14; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17)

WHERE: In the Lord's presence—in the "heavenlies"

(1 Thessalonians 4:17; 2 Corinthians 5:1-8)

WHO: Examiner: The Son of God (2 Corinthians 5:10; John 5:22)

Examined: Only believers from the church age (2 Corinthians 5:1-19)

HOW: The basis of the examination of each believer is:

The QUALITY of the believer's works (1 Corinthians 3:13-15)

The things done in the body—good or worthless (2 Corinthians 5:10)

REWARDS

An imperishable crown for victors over the old man.



Crown of rejoicing for soul winners.

Crown of life for enduring trials.

Crown of righteousness for loving His appearing.

Lost rewards for not watching yourself and losing growth.

GLORY

Varying capacity to manifest the glory of Christ, but each filled.

REIGN

Believers will reign with Christ.

5 Events for the Church Following the Rapture

Event No. 2 THE MARRIAGE OF THE LAMB

WHAT At the Rapture Christ, the bridegroom,

comes to take His bride, the church.

WHEN It occurs after the Judgement Seat of Christ ("Bema") and before the Second Coming of Christ.

WHERE Between the Rapture and the Second Coming, both the church and Christ are in heaven ("heavenlies")


WHO Apparently, only Christ and the church.




Note: The Marriage Supper of the Lamb takes place later on earth and includes Israel and perhaps Millennial Gentiles.




During the first half Israel will be relatively safe due to the covenant with Antichrist.

Holy Spirit As restrainer of evil He stops, but continues in personal salvation


144,000 Israelites 12,000 (men) from each tribe who have the seal of God



The Antichrist

(B. "The Bad Guys")

He will be a Gentile political leader from the old Roman region.

He is especially apt at international alliances and treaties.

He rises to power through international peace and prosperity.

He is personally very intelligent and persuasive.

He receives his authority and miraculous power from Satan directly.

He rules world-wide with absolute authority, changing laws and customs.

He makes a 7-year treaty with Israel, which he breaks after 3-1/2 years.

He is the bitter enemy of Israel, Christ, and believers.

He sets himself up as a god in Jerusalem, demanding worship.

He is judged by Christ at His Second Coming and cast into the lake of fire forever.

The False Prophet (The "second beast")

He is possibly a Jew who also receives his power from Satan.

He has the authority and power of the Antichrist.

He is highly influential in religious affairs.

His work is authenticated by deceiving signs and miracles.

He promotes worldwide worship of Antichrist as god.

He successfully deceives the unbelieving world.

He also has authority to control all worldwide commerce.

He will cause the 666 mark to be on everyone wishing to buy or sell.

He is judged by Christ at His Second Coming and cast into the lake of fire forever.

He will be removed from the earth and bound in the "abyss" so that he cannot deceive the nations during the 1,000 years.



The Millennium is a divine rule of righteousness.

It is God's final test of humanity under ideal conditions.

All outside sources of temptation will be removed from man.

The Spiritual Character of the Millennium



It will be a kingdom of **righteousness** (Ps. 96:10)

It will be a kingdom of complete **obedience** to God (Jer. 31:33)

It will be a kingdom of **holiness** (Is. 4:3-4)

It will be a kingdom of **truth** (Ps. 45:4)

It will be a kingdom characterized by the **fullness** of the Holy Spirit (Joel 2:28-29)

Conditions Existing Within the Millennium



Peace - international, national, and individual

Joy - due to the presence of the Lord

Holiness - the land, city of Jerusalem, Temple, and people

Glory - The full glory of God will be seen

Comfort - the King will personally minister to every need

Justice - perfect justice to every individual

Instruction - through instructions from the King
Curse removed - creation restored to productivity and beauty
Sickness removed - The King will be the healer

Full knowledge - the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord







From God the Father's side:

- The public earthly honoring of His Son
- Carrying out of God's promises to His Son regarding the throne of David
- Final Divine trial of sinful man prior to His destroying this earth
- God's answer to the prayer,
 "Thy kingdom come, they will be done on earth as it is in heaven"

From God the Son's side:

- He receives the kingdom of this world as He has been expecting
- He will reign in righteousness
- He will share all His kingly honors with His saints

- The physical changes made in the earth reveal some of the loving care God has for His saints


From the nations of the earth side:


- It will be a thousand years under the iron-rod scepter

 Many people born during the Tribulation will outwardly conform but never really get saved


• Satan will be released from the abyss to gather these unsaved and surround (threaten) Jerusalem

 And this present earth will be destroyed by fire


The Great White Throne Judgement




...And I saw a Great White Throne and Him Who sat upon it...

(Revelation 19:11)

- Death and Hades give up the dead in them for judgement
- The dead, great and small, stand before the throne (verse 12)
- The books are opened: The Book of Life and The Book of Deeds
- They are judged by what is written in the books—good and bad deeds
- If anyone's name is not found in the Book of Life, they are thrown into the Lake of Fire





- 10 The New Jerusalem and The Eternal State
- God will create a new heavens and a new earth.
- Christ will dwell among mankind.
- Christ has prepared a place for the saints The New Jerusalem
- It's a three dimensional city, 1500 miles on a side with a high wall.
- It has 12 pearl gates, 12 foundation stones, and a golden street.
- Christ is the temple there.
- There is no sun or moon God's glory is the light.
- A clear pure river will flow from God's throne.
- There will be no curse, crying, pain or death there.
- "His bond-servants shall serve Him; and they shall see His face...


