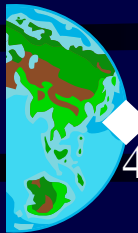
Abraham was faithful to God and moved from Ur to Haran to Canaan. There God began to build the nation Israel from his descendants, Isaac and Jacob (Israel).

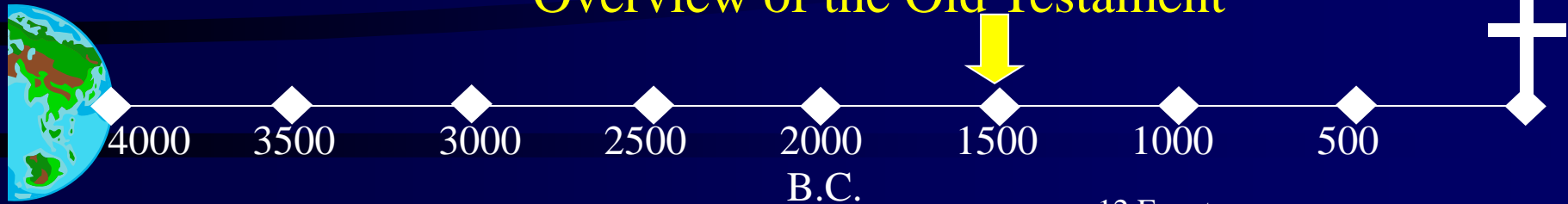
One of Jacob's 12 sons was Joseph, who through strange circumstances brought his Israelite family to Egypt

After Joshua, individual leaders, called judges, were the only leaders Israel had.

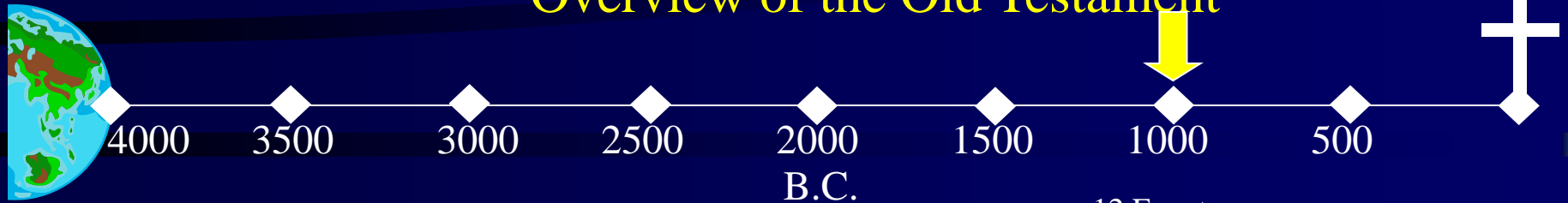

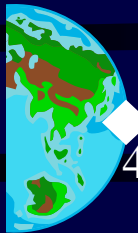

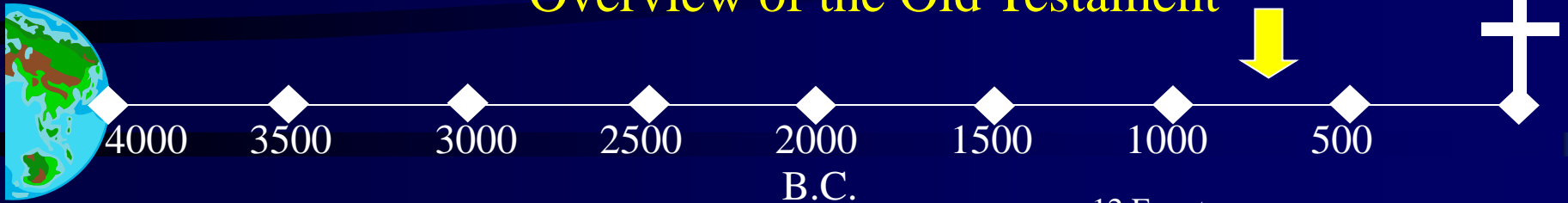
After Solomon, a civil war divided the nation into the Northern Kingdom, called Israel, and the Southern Kingdom, called Judah.

Israel in the north had 19 kings who were all bad and was exiled to Assyria, never to return until modern times (1948)



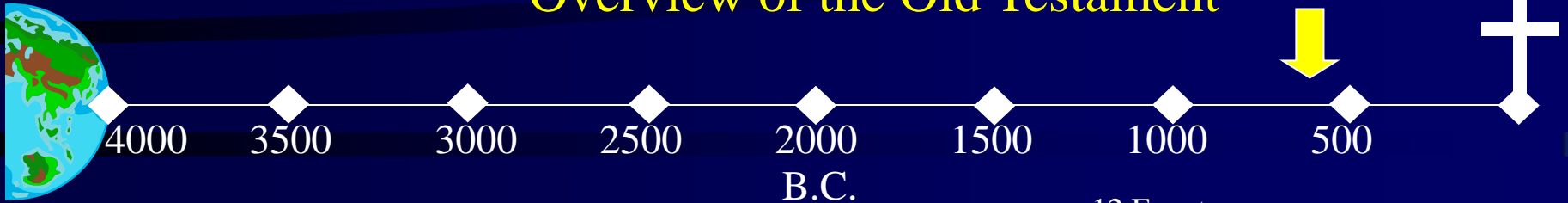

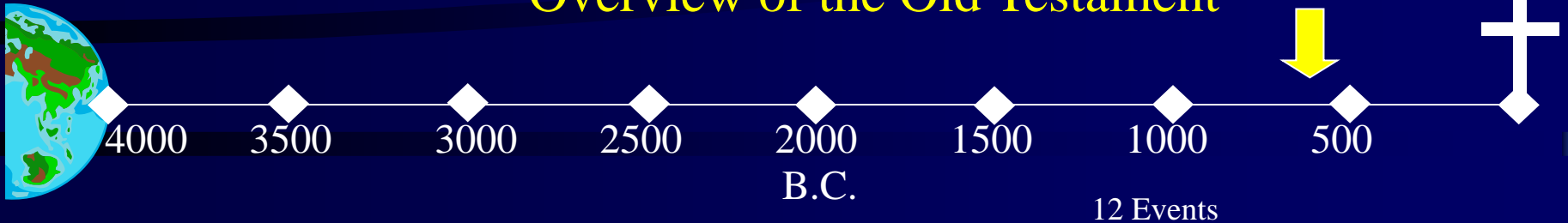

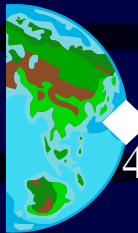

Then Judah returned to Jerusalem under Zerubbabel, Ezra, and Nehemiah. They rebuilt the temple and the city walls.



This ends the Old Testament, chronologically.
