
The Wisdom of God vs. the Wisdom of the World, Part 2

[This is a revision of a brochure, distributed by www.relationalconcepts.org, which I did years ago.] God commands us to know wisdom and instruction (Proverbs 1:1, see also 1:1-7, 8:1-36). But worldly wisdom has serious problems:

Worldly wisdom says it is good to be wealthy.

Godly wisdom says it is good to be poor (Luke 6:20; 9:58; Philippians 3:8).



Godly wisdom says I give to someone because it is good for me (Mark 12:42-43; Luke 6:38).

Worldly wisdom says you can keep some things a secret.

Godly wisdom says every secret will be revealed (Luke 12:2-3; Romans 2:16).

Worldly wisdom says there are many ways to God. **Godly wisdom** says there is only one way to God (John 14:6; Acts 4:12).

Worldly wisdom says unity is when we tolerate each other's viewpoint.

Godly wisdom says unity is when we all agree with God (1 Corinthians 1:10; 1 Timothy 6:3-5).

Worldly wisdom says sex should be between willing partners.

Godly wisdom says sex is only for marriage (Acts 15:29; 1 Corinthians 7:1-5).

Worldly wisdom says we should not let people take advantage of us.

Godly wisdom says we should let people take advantage of us (Luke 6:29; 1 Corinthians 13:7).

Worldly wisdom says people come and go. Institutions live on.

Godly wisdom says institutions come and go, but people live on (Matthew 25:46; 1 Corinthians 15:19).

Worldly wisdom says love is a two-way street. **Godly wisdom** says love is a one-way street (Matthew 5:46; 1 Corinthians 13).



Worldly wisdom says the Bible is a "2000-year-old book" not relevant for our progressive society.

Godly wisdom say the Bible is the inerrant, living, active Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16; Romans 15:4; Hebrews 4:12)

Worldly wisdom says to take care of yourself first. "Look out for number one."

Godly wisdom says regard one another as more important than yourselves (Philippians 2:3-4).

Worldly wisdom encourages revenge.

Godly wisdom says to leave revenge to God (Romans 12:19).

Worldly wisdom says a leader is someone who is followed.
