

What About... Discrimination Against Christians and More Specifically, the Bible

I was pondering the idea of why there is such a hatred for Christians and, more specifically, the Bible in society today. 2. Cultural Marxism – Often aims to deconstruct traditional values (including biblical ones) in favor of social revolution. This includes reshaping views on family, gender, and morality.

3. Certain Global Elites and Institutions – Some promote agendas that oppose biblical

values under the guise of progress, inclusivity, or science.

4. Entertainment and Media – Often mocks or marginalizes Christians, distorting the Bible or portraying faith as ignorance or hate.

5. Individually – *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God* (Romans 3:23)

Whether it is replacing BC/AD with BCE/CE, removing prayer from schools, or branding biblical truth as “intolerance,” there is a clear effort to push Jesus Christ and, specifically, the Bible to the margins of society.

But none of this surprises God. Jesus said:

“You will be hated by all for My name’s sake” (Matthew 10:22)

“If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated Me first” (John 15:18)
